## **Police donate 10 stolen & unclaimed bikes to G-Force**

Officers from Trafford South Integrated Neighbourhood Policing Team donated the cycles to help G-Force with their work with children, young people and adults.

## Report on the work done by G-Force & BOSS on Broomwood Park & the woods

- We have paid for and installed two new feature logs in Broomwood Park
- We have cleaned the woods and laid new woodchip paths
- We have cleared the two park flower beds which are ready to be planted up for the summer
- We will be planting the raised beds on the park with vegetables in the next few weeks
- We will be installing the 2 benches back into the park in the next few weeks in time for summer
- We are planning to plant more fruit bearing bushes along the fence, as well as ivy, to soften the stark fence line parallel to the School fields.
- Regular litter picks continue to happen on the park, Brooks Drive & the woods
- An new anti-dog poo initiative and a massive Estate wide clean up is planned in July
- We are in conversation with TMBC about increasing the level of attention the park is getting as it is looking very uncared for at the moment
- The 6 dead trees have been reported to Trafford who are looking to replace them during the next winter planting program.
